



Certified Patient Care Technician Program- Fact Sheet

Program Goal

The goal of this program is to train multidisciplinary healthcare professionals to provide basic nursing assistant care as well as other highly skilled functions in preparation for an entry level position in a variety of healthcare institutions.

Program Description

This creatively designed program is a combination of three very popular programs-CNA, Phlebotomy Technician and Electrocardiograph Technician. The program is designed to provide graduates with technical expertise to provide traditional & highly technical care to patients. Students are trained to be competent nursing aids, phlebotomy technicians and EKG technicians, capable of working in interdisciplinary healthcare teams in a variety of healthcare settings. Program Duration: 11 weeks

Program Eligibility: Must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or a GED.

Program Fees: \$4,695 with payment plan available upon request. This special program is highly discounted when taken as a combined package- compared to \$7000.

Program Certifications

Graduates are eligible to take the National Certification exams in all three areas- CAN, EKG & Phlebotomy.

Program Flexibility: We have flexible day, evening and weekend program schedules.
