



Home Health Aide Certification Program- Fact Sheet

Program goal

To train students to competently render hands-on personal care to patients, primarily in their homes.

Program description

Students will learn how to assist patients with personal tasks such as grooming, maintaining a clean and safe home environment, thus allowing those who would otherwise need a higher level of care in a hospital setting the opportunity to live a less expensive and higher quality of life in their homes. Students will also learn the reporting process- how to relate pertinent information to the appropriate authorities. Some states allow home health aides to administer medication or check vital signs under the supervision of a healthcare practitioner.

Program Duration: 3 weeks

Tuition and fees: \$995

Job flexibility

This program is suitable for people who wish to do this full time as well as people who already have full time jobs, but need supplemental incomes. This training will afford the flexibility of working with families to develop a schedule that matches your availability.

Eligibility: Must at least 18 years and have a high school diploma or GED.

Employment opportunities

Graduates from this program may find employment with healthcare facilities such as home healthcare agencies or private partnerships with families to provide home care to loved ones.
